

INGO/NGO Example Commitments

Example 1

We commit to delivering integrated eye care programmes in India, Kenya, and Nigeria, reaching 3 million people over five years. We will train 12,000 eye health workers, support cataract and refractive error services, deploy teleophthalmology for remote triage, strengthen routine data systems, and work with governments to improve referral pathways and sustainable financing.

Example 2

We commit to supporting eye health system strengthening in Southeast Asia and sub-Saharan Africa, reaching 4 million people over five years. We will build capacity of 15,000 health workers, expand community-based screening, implement electronic health and referral systems, enhance data use for decision-making, and support governments and partners to scale sustainable, people-centred eye care services.

Example 3

We commit to improving access to eye care in Kenya by reaching 800,000 people over five years. We will train 2,000 eye care workers, expand outreach clinics in rural counties, strengthen district-level referral systems, introduce digital patient tracking, and collaborate with county health systems to integrate eye care into primary healthcare and improve service quality.

Example 4

We commit to delivering high-quality eye care services across underserved districts in India, reaching 1.2 million people over five years. We will train 3,500 ophthalmic personnel, conduct community screening camps, scale low-cost cataract surgery services, implement digital records and follow-up systems, and work with public health programmes to strengthen integration and improve equity of access.

Example 5

By 2030, we will enable 500,000 people with diabetes across underserved communities in North America to access annual retinal screening, train 500 primary care providers in early DR detection, and ensure 25,000 people receive timely laser or anti-VEGF treatment through strengthened referral pathways and integrated NCD care.
